- 2. Be 55 years of age or older and an Active member.

- 5. Write a brief (one page) summary of the Road Scholar experience, to be filed with the Alpha Xi State Personal Growth Chairman four (4) weeks from the date of completion of the Road Scholar Program. Please include one (1) or more photos or slides to share with Alpha Xi State Convention display.
- B. The application for an Alpha Xi State Road Scholar Program will include:
 - 1. Completion of the form available from the Alpha Xi State Personal Growth Chairman.
 - 2. A letter of recommendation from your Chapter President.
- C. Applicants are urged to apply again if unsuccessful in obtaining an award. Members are limited to one award.
- D. One (1) Road Scholar Award of \$500 will be available during any one year.
- E. Awardees will be notified within one month of each deadline, and awardee's name will be announced at an Alpha Xi State function.
